

Christian Service FAQs

Below you'll find answers to some of our most frequently asked questions regarding students' Christian Service requirements. 1. I completed all of my service hours over the summer. Will they count?

- a. If a student completed their required service hours for the year over the summer, as long as they fit into their required field/area, they will be counted by the Theology teacher once the student provides the signed paperwork.
- b. Any student who completed service hours over the summer that DID NOT fit in with their required field/areas will be given half of their years' service hours, and the rest will be added on as extra, so that once the student has reached the required 100 hours, their add-on hours will be added and help the student work toward the 200 service hours award.

2. I am an upperclassman and delinquent in hours from the previous year(s.) How can I fix that?

- a. Any student who has not completed hours from the previous years will be required to finish them and turn them in to Mrs. Raiche in the Campus Ministry/Counseling office. These may be done in any field due to the fact that there were no specified fields in the past.
- b. Along with their hours from the previous year, students are required to finish the hours for the current year. Any student who does not do this will not be allowed to register for ANY extracurricular activities beginning in the 2012-2013 school year until they have completed the hours.
- c. ALL SENIORS MUST HAVE 100 HOURS COMPLETED, APPROVED, AND RECORDED IN ORDER TO WALK ON GRADUATION DAY.

3. I have completed my hours for my current year and would like to begin working on hours for the next year. Can I?

- a. Any student who wishes to work on hours for their upcoming year may do so, as long as they are within the parameters of the next years' service group requirement.
- b. However, each student is in charge of keeping track of their signed service forms so they may turn them in to the teacher the following year. THEY MAY NOT BE TURNED IN TO THEIR CURRENT TEACHERS OR MRS. RAICHE or there will be too much confusion.

4. I worked at Manogue with my team or class. Do I get service hours?

- a. 8 service hours a year may still be obtained by working at Manogue with your team or for an event. YOU MUST PREAPPROVE THIS WITH YOUR CURRENT THEOLOGY TEACHER first.

5. All School Service Opportunities—what's that?

- a. Throughout the year, all school service opportunities will be presented by your theology teachers and the Campus Ministry office. ANY student may attend and receive service hours for these, no matter what their field. All that is required is signed and filled out [Christian Service Forms](#) that will then be turned in to your theology teacher.

6. I forgot to get a signature from my supervisor!

- a. Students MUST get a signature from their supervisor along with the name and phone number of the organization.
- b. No [Christian Service Forms](#) will be accepted with the parent/guardian signature. Please remember to always bring a service hours form with you, even to Manogue-sponsored Events. This will eliminate any confusion and questions as to where a student did their service.

7. I have already finished ALL of my required 100 hours and they have been approved. Will they still count?

- a. You must get a printout from Mrs. Raiche in the Campus Ministry office which both proves and details your completed hours. You are then to show this to your teacher so they mark that you have in fact completed your hours for graduation. YOU MUST ALSO COMPLETE AT LEAST 2 HOURS OF SERVICE IN YOUR REQUIRED FIELD THAT YEAR. This is to ensure that you and your classmates are all undergoing the same experience that you will then reflect on at the end of the year.

8. I'm still not sure what to do...
