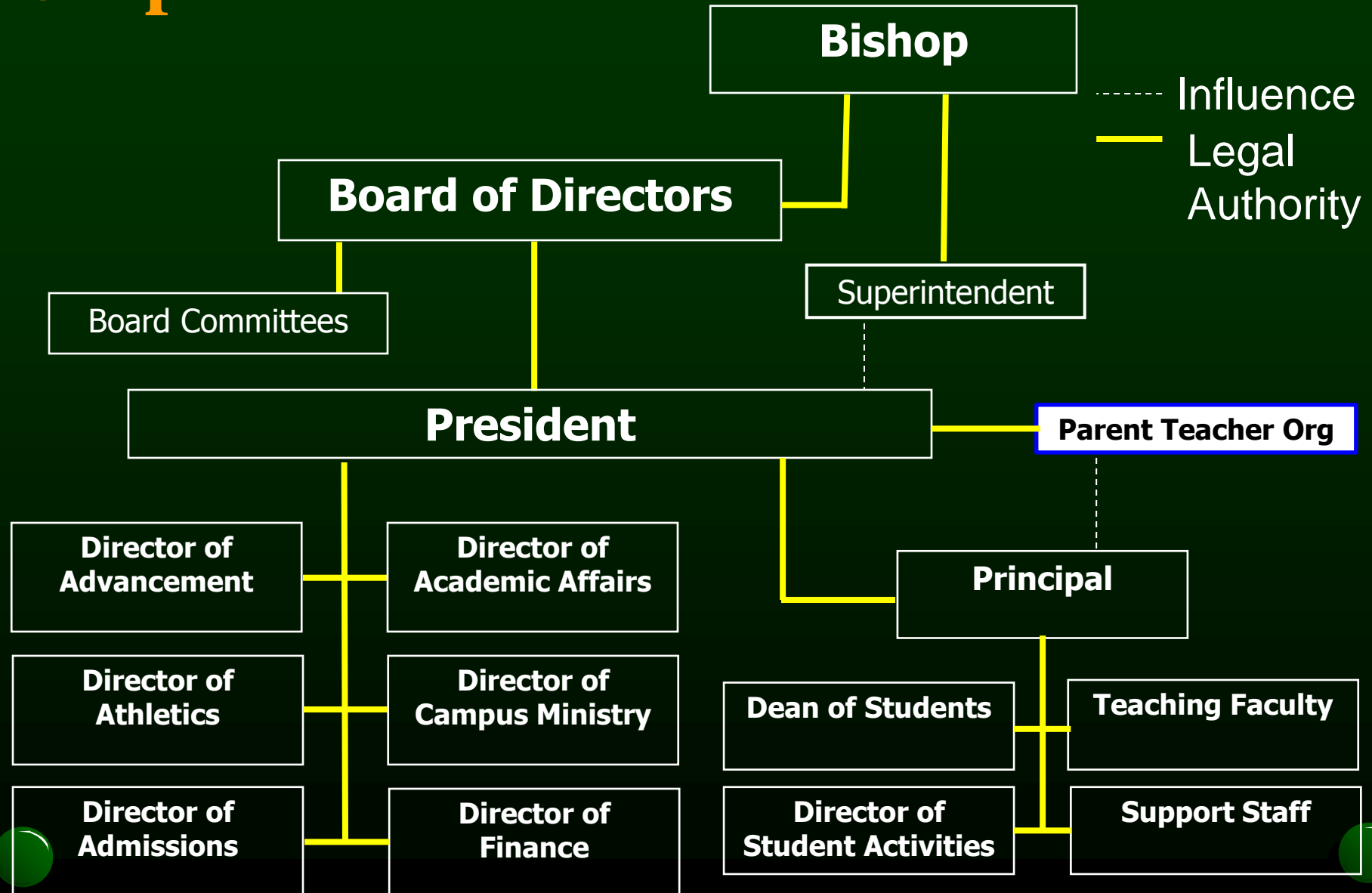

Additional Opportunities for Growth

- Continued emphasis on broadening the influence and sharpening the focus of the Bishop Manogue experience (curriculum and charism)
- Continue to expand the performing and visual arts program, especially as it is such a vital component of the Catholic liturgical / faith experience

Additional Opportunities for Growth

- The Visiting Committee commends the comprehensive retreat program at Bishop Manogue but also recommends that the school require students to attend either a Quest or Kiaros retreat before graduation.
 - One aspect of the faith formation of every Catholic school student is the opportunity to grow and change from the experience of God in a retreat experience.

Recommendations

1. Integrate the Schoolwide Action Plan (WCEA) with the existing Strategic Plan
 - Incorporate the 7 plans of the Self Study with the 12 plans of the school's Strategic Plan
2. Create “stand alone” plans within the Strategic Plan
 - Umbrella effect
3. Limit production to 3 plans/year
