

Golf: Osborne tied for fourth at state

Bishop Manogue sophomore Ollie Osborne shot a 1-over par 73 Tuesday at the Division I state golf tournament at Reflection Bay in Las Vegas and is tied for 4th place.

Osborne had the best day by a Northern Nevada golfer.

Several Northern Nevada golfers shot 77 Tuesday and are in an eight-way tie for 11th, including from Manogue, Michael Bove and Cole Skach; from Galena, Connor Motherway, Jay Babu and Presley Mackelburg and from Reed, Jayce Robinson.

Nate Daylo from Reed shot 78 and Scott Rescigno from Galena had an 80.

Sam Dickey from Arbor View and Jack Trent from Palo Verde are tied for the lead after each shot a 70.

Also from the North, Manogue's Tyler Humphreys shot an 83; Reno's Thomas Zumtobel shot 84; Galena's Press Labrie shot 87 as did Reno's Joshua Fleiner and Spanish Springs' Nick Frankoski.

In the team standings, Galena is fourth at 398, followed by Manogue at 399. Palo Verde leads at 375, followed by Coronado at 388 and Arbor View at 389.

The tournament concludes Wednesday.

In Division I-A golf, at Mountain Falls in Pahrump, Faith Lutheran leads with a 389, followed by Pahrump Valley at 411 Elko at 434 Spring Creek at 442, Boulder City at 449 and Fallon at 450.

Charlie Magruder of Faith Lutheran was low at 67. From the Northern Nevada schools, Pierce Johnson of Elko is tied for ninth with an 81. Daniel Mahlke from Spring Creek shot an 82 and Kelvin Cann from Fallon shot an 83, along with Cauy Mead from Elko.

In Division III, also at Mountain Falls, Mitchell Cornell of Incline fired a 69 to take the lead. Collin Young of White Pine is second at 72, along with Griffin Cooper of Yerington.

North Tahoe leads the team standings with a 422; followed by Meadows (444); Incline (446); Lake Mead (453); Whittell (463) and Needles (465).
