ADMISSIONS & ENROLLMENT TIMELINE

ADMISSION STEPS:

Step 1: Complete the online application at www.bishopmanogue.org/admissions/apply/

Step 2: Submit a current grade report; if you are applying for an **early** decision, submit your final report card from your seventh grade year.

All potential students must submit a current discipline report, a current immunization report, a copy of student's birth certificate and up to date transcripts/grades.

Step 3: Schedule an interview by going to www.meetme.so/BMCHSInterview

Step 4: Once an acceptance letter is received, follow the dates below for creating a FACTS Tuition Account, and if desired, a separate FACTS Financial Aid and Scholarship account.

Please Note: Only Freshman and transfer students who have applied by November 1, 2017 (**early** decision) will be eligible to apply their application fee to their enrollment fee. Enrollment fee must be paid by January 24, 2018.

September 1 Application available online - **Early** application fee \$75.00

September 20 Annual Fall Open House at Bishop Manogue Catholic High School 4:00 – 7:00

November 1 Deadline for **early** applications.

November 17 **Early** decision letters will be mailed.

December 1 Application fee increases to \$125.00

December 5 **Early** acceptances: create a FACTS account to prepare for enrollment

January 24	<p>Early decision Freshman Academic Night: 5:30pm in the Student Community Center</p> <p>Four-Year Plan and early priority registration for classes will be provided. Enrollment assistance for new families in the Knowledge Center following the Academic Presentation.</p>
February 16	<p>All scholarship applications due for first priority consideration. www.bishopmanogue.org/admissions/scholarships/</p> <p>2016 Tax Return and 2017 W-2's must be submitted to FACTS by this date for scholarship and financial aid consideration.</p> <p>Financial aid applications may still be received after this date but may not receive aid if all funding has been dispersed.</p>
March 16	<p>Second round of acceptance letters are mailed</p>
March 30	<p>Financial Aid and Scholarship awards will be mailed to all families</p>
April 9	<p>Enrollment for all families must be complete. A late fee will be applied after this date.</p>
April 25	<p>Second Round Freshman Academic Night: 5:30pm in the Student Community Center Four-Year Plan and Registration for classes will be provided.</p>
May 15 & 16	<p>Challenge Exams for Freshman Course Placement in Core Classes, 4:00pm in the Student Community Center</p>
June 12	<p>New Miner Social and Orientation Night, 5:30pm in the Chapel, Students and Parents</p>
June 15	<p>Parish Discount Forms due to the Business Office. No late forms will be accepted.</p>
July 1	<p>First Tuition Payment Due</p>
