

## Accessing your PSAT 8/9 Scores

Congratulations! Your scores from the PSAT 8/9 will be available through the College Board website next week on December 11. You **MUST** set up a College Board account to retrieve your scores. This online account will also allow you to:

- View scores from future PSAT, SAT, and AP tests
- Register for future SAT exams
- Connect with Khan Academy for a free personalized PSAT/SAT study plan
- Complete the CSS PROFILE for financial aid through certain colleges

It is important to keep this information in a safe place. You will keep the same USERNAME for your entire time in high school. DO NOT SET UP A NEW ACCOUNT EACH TIME YOU TAKE AN EXAM. How to set-up an account:

1. Go to: <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org/>. Click "Sign Up".
2. Complete the required information.
  - a. Name: Use your legal name (no nicknames).
  - b. Email address: Use your personal (**not your school**) email address.
  - c. Graduation date: June 2021.
  - d. Username: Must be 6-15 characters including letters and/or numbers.
  - e. Password: Must be 7-15 characters with at least 1 letter and 1 number.
  - f. Parent information is optional; it is not required.

Your scores should be automatically linked to your account when they become available. If they are not, you will need an access code. Below is the name that the College Board has on file for you (from your test registration) and your personal access code for your PSAT 8/9 scores.
