

Sophomores: Accessing your PSAT Scores

The Preliminary SAT (PSAT) measures college readiness in evidence-based reading and writing, as well as mathematics. By logging on to the College Board's Student Scores website, you can view your score report online with detailed information about the questions. The online account will keep track of your PSAT results throughout high school and will allow you to register for the SAT test.

If you **DO NOT** already have an account, please do the following:

1. Go to: <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org/>. Click "Sign Up".
2. Complete the required information. Some helpful notes:

Name	Use your legal name (no nicknames)
Email	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use the email address you provided on your test answer sheets.• This address should be your personal (not your school) email address.• Every email may be linked to <i>one student only</i>. This means that you may not use a parent's email address if it was already used for a College Board account with an older sibling.
Graduation Date	June 2020

If your scores do not automatically link to your account, you will need an access code. Below is the name that the College Board has on file for you (from your test registration) and your personal access codes for the PSAT exams you have taken at BMCHS.
