



Update on COVID-19: March 9, 2020

Dear Bishop Manogue Community,

Bishop Manogue Catholic High School has made the difficult decision to cancel all school-related travel to out-of-state destinations until further notice. All in-state athletic events, academic events, and conferences will continue as planned.

Our team is continuing to work closely with local health agencies and will keep our school community informed of any additional changes. The health of our students and school community is of extreme importance, and we appreciate your understanding as we work to foster the well being of our school.

We ask for your patience and understanding in this unforeseen and unprecedented situation. Our team will send frequent updates that may change or alter the information sent in a previous communication. This is a fluid situation, and we are working with the direction of the Health District and in support of our local partners.

ADDITIONAL BMCHS PREPARATION AND PROTOCOL:

CLEANING AND HYGIENE PROCEDURES.

BMCHS is working closely with the Washoe County Health District and Diocese of Reno to help minimize the spread of contagious disease on campus. Increased measures include:

- Increased cleaning and disinfecting of school property with CDC approved cleaning products.
- Encouraging all students and staff to stay home when sick
- Encouraging all students and staff who exhibit any flu-like symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath, chills, and aches) to go home and not to return until symptoms have subsided.
- Providing additional hand sanitizing stations on campus
- Strongly encouraging regular hand washing throughout the day, especially before meals and accommodating extra time students need to wash their hands properly.
